Scripture Reading: Romans 13:8-14

***The good life is a process, not a state of being.
It is a direction, not a destination. —Carl Rogers***

*A wind came up out of the sea, /
... And hurried landward far away, / Crying, "Awake! it is the day."
It said unto the forest, "Shout! / Hang all your leafy banners out!"
It touched the wood-bird's folded wing, / And said, "O bird, awake and sing."
And o'er the farms, "O chanticleer, / Your clarion blow; the day is near."
It whispered to the fields of corn, / "Bow down, and hail the coming morn."
It shouted through the belfry-tower, / "Awake, O bell! proclaim the hour."
It crossed the churchyard with a sigh, / And said, "Not yet! in quiet lie."*

Every morning has a moment when the world begins to wake. The light sneaks through the window, the air changes, and something inside you slowly stirs. The apostle Paul uses this very image when he writes, "It is now the moment for you to wake from sleep," (v. 11). But he's not talking about physical sleep — he's talking about spiritual alertness.

Paul reminds us that we live between night and day ... between the world's darkness and God's glory. "The night is far gone," he says, "the day is near," reminding us that our lives as followers of Jesus are lives of watching, waiting and living in the light, even while at the same time, shadows remain.

And then Paul gives a simple, beautiful instruction: "Owe no one anything, except to love one another" (v. 8). Love is the one debt we never finish paying. Love is the true sign that we live in the light of Christ.

This is a powerful reminder. Though our mobility changes, though routines shift, the calling to love remains fully active. Paul contrasts "works of darkness" with "armor of light," because love is not passive; it is protective. It lifts, guards, heals and reflects Christ's character. To "put on the Lord Jesus Christ" is to live clothed in his compassion, patience and grace.

So, perhaps what we can take away from today's reading is that, as long as we have breath, we have the ability to reflect Christ's love. Our lives, in other words, can reflect the dawning of God's day.
